- Upon arrival, **please sanitise your hands as you go in** using the hand sanitiser on the table by the main door. **Please take a leaflet** from one of the steward which details the safety measure we have put in place.
- Please keep to advised **social distancing, respect the space of other visitors** and **avoid touching surfaces unnecessarily.**
- Please **used the designated areas** for private prayer. When you have finished, please **leave your leaflet on the chair** so future visitors and those cleaning the church know the space has been used .
- Unfortunately we are **unable to open the toilet to visitors** at the moment.
- **If you handle any of the leaflets about the church, please take it with you** even if you feel you do not want to pay for it. That said, any donation would like to make can be placed in the wall safe and will be gratefully received.
- **Please remember to sanitise your hands as you leave the building.**
