Whether you have ten minutes or an hour a day for your Lent preparation, there are a wide range of books, apps and websites to suit all tastes.

## Books

## Apps

- **#livelent God’s Story, Our Story** - A free app from the Church of England with daily prayers, reflections and a family activity. As well as the full text, there is an audio version to accompany the text
- **Lectio 365**—A free daily devotional app which helps you pray the Bible 365 days a year.
- **Reflect: Christian Mindfulness**—A free app with Christian meditations, prayers and Lectio Divina
- **Soultime Christian Meditation and Mindfulness**— This app offers meditation and mindfulness to draw us closer to God in prayer and contemplation. With quick access to verses to support us whatever our mood.

- **Sacred Space website**: Daily prayer, weekly thoughts, Lenten online retreat as well as prayer resources
- **40 Words for 40 Days of Lent**: Produced by the Diocese of Norwich, Revd Canon Susanna Gunner has chosen 40 words for each day of Lent. A different word will be under the spotlight each day with ideas to mull over. Sign up on the website or access them through Facebook, Twitter or Instagram.
